2024 IMPACT REPORT

In 2024, the Bellevue Police Foundation committed to **provide future equipment grants totaling over \$195,727** to the Bellevue Police Department for essential equipment that will enhance the department's ability to ensure public safety.

Communication earpieces for the SWAT team improves coordination and response times during critical operations. New **unmanned aerial systems (drones)** for patrol units will allow for more efficient surveillance and rapid response to incidents.

Eight rifle-rated ballistic shields and a **portable ballistic coverage device** for patrol units provide better protection for officers and others in high-risk situations. Finally, the Foundation provided **30 chairs for the records department** to improve their work environment.

Our ongoing support to enhance BPD operations included investments of **over \$13,000 for various community programs** and **\$9,200 for the K9 unit support**.

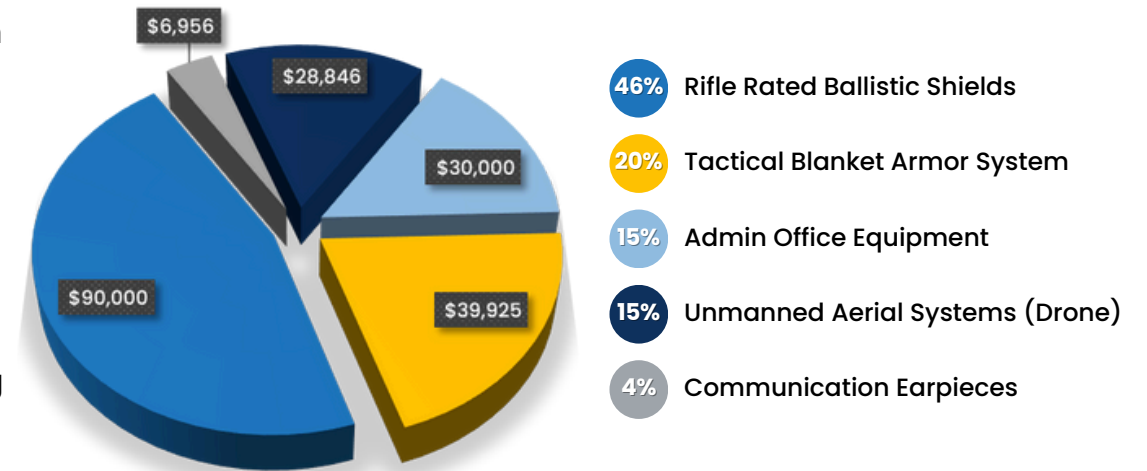

2024 Heroes & Helpers Event

To help the Police Department stay connected to the community it serves, BPF provided funds for community events that serve well over 1,000 people, such as National Night Out, Halloween on the Hill, and Battle of the Badges.

In 2024, through our Heroes and Helpers program, BPD served a record number of homeless and at-risk youth with extra resources during the holiday season.

OFFICER BERETA RECOVERY FUND

Following Officer Kevin Bereta's life threatening injury incurred while on duty at a Vice-Presidential motorcade in 2023, Bellevue Police Foundation raised over \$50,000 in 2024 to support him and his family.

Miraculously, Officer Bereta returned to light duty in August 2024. He and his family are eternally grateful to the donors who supported him in a very difficult time.
